


Who should attend this workshop?

There are six major components to the training:

- **Anatomy:** Find and palpate the relevant musculoskeletal structures.
- **Assessment:** Learn and practice all the injury assessment tests for the shoulder.
- **Theory:** Learn how to use the history, positive assessment test findings, and results of palpation to determine which structures are injured. We'll discuss the possible causes of injury as well as effective treatments.
- **Integration:** Integrate what you've learned about the theory and assessment procedures through hands-on learning games and supervised clinics.
- **Technique:** Learn and practice detailed treatment techniques to eliminate adhesive scar tissue.
- **Clinic:** On the final day of the training, practice your skills in an injury assessment clinic, free and open to the public, under Dr. Benjamin's supervision.
